Additionally, AutoCAD is the only CAD software with native support for DWG files. DWG is an industry standard for defining the electronic format for AutoCAD drawings. History AutoCAD was originally developed by John Walker, who was assisted by Steve May, a member of the Colorado Center for Computer Graphics at Colorado State University, who was named an ACM Fellow in 1990. In 1982, Walker began the development of AutoCAD, an early CAD program specifically designed to run on low-end microcomputers. The first version of AutoCAD, with a total cost of \$5,500, was developed in August 1982. It was completed in January 1983 and was released to the public on February 1, 1983. The initial version of AutoCAD was only available as a software program, and was not distributed as a machine-readable drawing format. However, the first version of AutoCAD created a format called ACD, short for AutoCAD Drawing. This format was a raster-based drawing file created by scanning into a flatbed scanner. AutoCAD users could import these drawings into the program using the Scan Edit function. The Scan Edit function was released in AutoCAD version 1.1 in November 1983. AutoCAD users could also create 2D drawings by hand. In 1983, Walker and his team joined with a group at Ohio University to create a drawing translator called "Drawmaster". The original Drawmaster CAD translated drawings in the ACD format
